Prison Ministry

"I was in prison and you came to visit me ... I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me." Matthew 25:36, 40

The Bedford Hills Correctional Facility houses 850-900 women. The majority of the women incarcerated there are mothers, and most are poor. The financial crisis created by COVID-19 has hit the families of the incarcerated especially hard, further limiting their ability to pay for the transportation that would allow them to visit.

Greeting cards, which the inmates do not normally have access to, help them maintain bonds of love with their families. This has been shown to result in better outcomes for both the inmates and their children and families. Calendars are also greatly appreciated to help inmates count the days and add a note of cheer in their cells.



If you have **greeting cards** lying around, **forever stamps** or current **calendars** that you can part with, please leave them in the basket on the long table in the church lobby and we will make sure that they get to the inmates. Thank you.
